Panthers Close Out Home Schedule Hosting Austin Peay

Eastern Illinois vs. Austin Peay

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois will be recognizing the 14 members of its senior class prior to the start of the game. Included in that group are members of the first full recruiting class for current head coach Kim Dameron who took over the program in 2014. That group had posted three straight winning seasons (2015-17) including an FCS playoff bid in 2015.
- With a bye week in the schedule EIU senior wide receiver Alexander Hollins has dropped to number two in the FCS in touchdown receptions. Hollins has 13 touchdown catches this year which ranks tied for eighth in OVC single season history. This year's FCS leader is Jacksonville State wide receiver Josh Pearson with 15 touchdown catches.
- EIU is 4-2 coming off the bye week since the 2012 season. Last season EIU had a bye week before ending the year with a 28-13 loss at Austin Peay. The previous season, EIU also had a late season bye and responded with a 24-0 win at Eastern Kentucky to end the season with a 6-5 record.
- Isaiah Johnson rushed for 128 yards and two touchdowns against Eastern Kentucky in the Panthers last game on Oct. 27. Johnson became the 29th player in school history to pass the 1,000 yard rushing mark for their career. He now has 1,099 career yards which is 27th on the EIU all-time list.
- Sophomore linebacker Dytarious Johnson added a tackle for loss to his season total at Eastern Kentucky as he ranks second in the OVC in tackles for loss this year with 12. Johnson needs 3.5 tackles for loss over the final two games of the year to move into the EIU single season top ten. He posted a season high 5.5 tackles for loss against UT Martin.

THE SERIES

- Eastern Illinois and Austin Peay will be playing for the 19th time. The Panthers hold a 14-4 all-time series lead. The Governors did snap an eight game EIU win streak in the series last season with a 28-13 win in Clarksville. In those previous eight games EIU won by an average score of 45-15. EIU's last loss at home to Austin Peay was on senior day in 2008 when the Governors upset EIU 15-13.

• Quarterback Johnathan Brantley had his OVC record streak of consecutive passes thrown without an interception end on the first play at Eastern Kentucky. Brantley's streak ended at 230 passes. On the season Brantley ranks 10th in the OVC in completion percentage at 65.6 percent. The EIU and OVC record for season passing completion percentage is 68.3 by Mike Simpson in 1997.

• Nick Bruno knocked home a 32-yard field goal at Eastern Kentucky as the senior kicker ranks second all-time at EIU in both career field goals (42) and extra points made (141). He currently ranks 15th in the FCS this season in field goal percentage having made 10-of-12 with both misses from outside of 40 yards. At EKU, Bruno moved into fourth on the EIU career scoring list with 264 points.

• Senior wide receivers Alexander Hollins and Aaron Gooch have been a solid one, two, punch for the EIU offense this season. Both players currently rank in the top 30 in the FCS in receptions with Hollins in sixth with 71 catches and Gooch in 23rd with 52. In addition both players are on the verge of joining the EIU career top ten for receptions (Ryan Voss / Rob Mehalic tied for 9th at 126) as Gooch has 121 catches and Hollins 118.

• Alexander Hollins and Aaron Gooch both passed the 1,000 yard receiving mark for their career earlier this season. Hollins has 1,605 career receiving yards in just two seasons at EIU and ranks 14th all-time. Gooch has 1,220 career yards to land at 21st on the Panthers list.

• Walter Payton Award candidate Alexander Hollins currently ranks in the FCS top ten in touchdowns (2nd / 13), receptions (6th / 71) and receiving yards (9th / 911). All three of those numbers have also landed him on the EIU single season charts. The 13 touchdown receptions are tied for fourth. The 71 receptions are sixth. The 911 yards are 12th as he became just the 13th player in school history to pass the 900 yard mark in a season.

• With a lot of the focus on Alexander Hollins and Aaron Gooch this season, the Panthers other two starting receivers both had career games at Eastern Kentucky. James Sheehan had his first career 100 yard receiving game with six catches for 108 yards. Nick Atoyebe caught a season high seven passes for 75 yards.

• Despite the Panthers losing their top kick returner Matt Reyna to injury, EIU still averaged 28 yards per kickoff return at Eastern Kentucky. For the season EIU ranks 35th in the FCS and third in the OVC in kickoff return average at 22 yards per return. Reyna did have a kickoff return for touchdown against Indiana State covering 96 yards.

• Edwyn Brown made ten tackles against Eastern Kentucky including six solo stops. Brown is a redshirt freshman that has moved from corner to safety this season making starts in all six OVC games. He is fifth on the team in tackles with 44 including one interception. Brown became the sixth different player to post double figure tackles in a game this season.

• Junior linebacker Joe Caputo had the Panthers only sack at Eastern Kentucky forcing a fumble that was recovered by Levi Watson. Caputo is EIU's leading tackler on the season with 69 tackles including seven for loss with 1.5 sacks. As a team EIU has only been able to get to the quarterback ten times with Watson the team leader with three sacks.

• After not forcing a turnover in their three non-conference games, Eastern Illinois has now forced a turnover in six straight games with a fumble recovery against Eastern Kentucky. The Panthers had forced multiple turnovers in their first five OVC games this year. EIU now has 12 turnovers gained for the year to rank fifth in the conference. EIU is third in the conference in turnovers gained in league games.

• The Eastern Illinois passing offense is currently ranked sixth in the FCS and first in the OVC averaging 322.8 yards per game through the air. EIU has already completed the fourth most passes in school history with 270. The Panthers are on pace to finish in the top five for most passing yards in school history (need 308 yds for 5th) and pass attempts (need 26 att for 5th).

EIU HEAD COACH KIM DAMERON

Kim Dameron is in his fifth season as the Eastern Illinois head football coach. Dameron led the Panthers to the FCS playoffs in 2015 as EIU was ranked 23rd in the final FCS Coaches poll. Dameron was the defensive coordinator at Louisiana Tech prior to taking the EIU head job and has more than 15 years of experience as a defensive coordinator with more than 30 years of experience as a college coach. Dameron served as the EIU defensive coordinator in 2000 helping the program rebound from a 2-10 season in 1999 to an 8-4 record and FCS playoff appearance in 2000. Dameron played football at Arkansas appearing in four bowl games between 1979-82. He is a 1983 graduate of Arkansas. Complete Coach Kim Dameron bio available on page 6 of EIU game notes...

AUSTIN PEAY HEAD COACH WILL HEALY

In his second season at Austin Peay, Will Healy quickly turned around the fortunes of the Austin Peay football program leading the Governors to an 8-4 record. Now in his third season at the helm of the APSU program they were selected second in the OVC preseason poll. Healy holds a 12-20 record overall after not winning a game his opening season in Clarksville. He is a 2008 graduate of Richmond and was the team captain on the Spiders FCS National Championship team. He then worked for six seasons on the staff at Chattanooga

SCOUTING AUSTIN PEAY

Picked to finish second in the OVC preseason poll, Austin Peay enters the weekend at 4-5 overall, 2-4 in the OVC. The Governors need to win their final two games of the season to post their first back-to-back winning seasons since 1983 and 1984. Sophomore quarterback Jeremiah Oatsvall is a dynamic player that has rushed for 435 yards and six touchdowns while passing for 1,250 yards and 14 scores. Kentel Williams has rushed for 684 yards and ranks second in the OVC this season. On defense linebacker Gunnar Scholato is third in the OVC in tackles with 87. Jaison Williams has ten tackles for loss while Nate Howard has 9.5.

ON THIS DATE IN EIU HISTORY

Nov. 10, 2007 - Eastern Illinois returned a kickoff and an interception for a touchdown as the No. 22 ranked Panthers beat Jacksonville State on the road 37-23 as they ended the season making a third straight trip to the FCS playoffs. Quentin Ponius returned the opening kickoff of the second half 96 yards for score. Michael Torres would help seal the win returning an interception 40 yards for a touchdown in the fourth quarter.

SENIOR DAY

Eastern Illinois will be playing its fifth senior day game under current head coach Kim Dameron. The Panthers are 2-2 in previous senior day games at O'Brien Field and have won four of their last six.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.

OVC SUCCESS

**KIM DAMERON****(Arkansas, 1983) -- 5th Season (Career Record 24-23, 21-11 OVC)**

Kim Dameron was hired as the 24th head coach in program history and the fifth in the NCAA Division I era in January of 2014.

The 2017 season may have been one of the most pulse stopping in recent years as the Panthers posted their third straight winning season under Dameron with all six victories coming by three points or less with a total margin of victory of 15 points for the year. Three of the wins were in overtime with two of them coming in double overtime. The wins on the season came in a variety of ways with two last play touchdown wins, two defensive stands, one game winning field goal and one game winning field goal block. EIU placed seven players on the All-OVC team and had defensive back Mark Williams earn Freshman All-American honors.

In 2016 the Panthers quickly climbed into the FCS playoff picture as they knocked off FBS member Miami (Ohio) and beat No. 5 ranked Illinois State in the Mid-America Classic. Dameron would guide EIU to a No. 13 ranking in the polls at the midway portion of the season. The Panthers would face several key injuries late in the season and finished the year at 6-5 overall following a 24-0 win at Eastern Kentucky to end the season. EIU was 4-4 in the OVC. The Panthers had four players earn All-OVC honors with Devin Church and Seth McDonald both earning first team honors.

Dameron returned the Panthers to the FCS playoffs in 2015 as EIU won seven of their last eight regular season games to finish with a 7-4 regular season record. EIU lost in the opening round of the FCS playoffs at Northern Iowa. The Panthers were ranked No. 23 in the final FCS Coaches poll after making their 16th all-time FCS playoff appearance. During the season Dameron's team produced six All-OVC players including co-Defensive Player of the Year Dino Fanti. Dameron would have his first player from Eastern Illinois drafted in May of 2016 when linebacker Kamu Grugier-Hill became a sixth round selection of the New England Patriots.

In his first season Dameron coached the Panthers to a 5-7 record including 5-3 in the Ohio Valley Conference as the Panthers were in the championship race until the final weeks of the season. Dameron's first career victory came on Sept. 20 against Austin Peay as the Panthers won 63-7. In the game EIU tied a school record for rushing yards with 413. The team featured three All-American selections including first team offensive lineman Collin Seibert and freshman All-American kicker Nick Bruno. Dameron's squad had five first team All-OVC selections and five second team All-OVC honorees. The team was among the best on both sides of the ball in the OVC ranking second in total offense (11th nationally) and third in total defense.

Dameron spent the 2013 season as the defensive coordinator at Louisiana Tech where he directed a much improved defensive unit. The Bulldogs finished ranked 69th in the nation in total defense under Dameron's direction after being ranked 120th the previous season. Dameron's defense was the fourth most-improved squad in the FBS last season.

An experienced defensive coach with more than 15 years as a defensive coordinator Dameron took over an Eastern Illinois program that advanced to the FCS playoff quarterfinals last season. It is Dameron's second stint in Charleston as he previously worked as the defensive coordinator at EIU in 2000 as a member of head coach Bob Spoo's staff. During that 2000 season, Dameron helped transform the Panthers defense as they rebounded from a 2-10 season in 1999 to 8-4 and Ohio Valley Conference Champions in 2000.

Dameron spent three seasons as the safeties coach at Ole Miss as the team appeared in two Cotton Bowls. Two of his players were selected in the NFL draft as his pass defense unit ranked 11th in the NCAA in pass efficiency defense and 15th in pass defense.

Prior to his stint at Ole Miss, Dameron was the defensive coordinator at Louisiana-Monroe as the program became bowl eligible at the FBS level for the first time in 2007 while also picking up a win over Alabama. The ULM defense led the Sun Belt Conference in fewest points allowed and ranking third nationally in turnovers gained.

Dameron has previous stops as the defensive coordinator at Stephen F. Austin and as the secondary coach at Cincinnati and UNLV. He spent the 1999 season as the secondary coach in the Canadian Football League with the Toronto Argonauts.

He has previous FCS coaching experience on the staffs of Murray State and Missouri State where he helped coach both teams to FCS playoff appearances.

Dameron began his coaching career as a graduate assistant
