Panthers End October With Road Trip To Eastern Kentucky

Eastern Illinois at Eastern Kentucky Roy Kidd Stadium (20,000) • Richmond, Ky. October 27, 2018 • 12 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- · Bryce Dewberry was named the Ohio Valley Conference Newcomer of the Week following the Panthers win over UT Martin. Dewberry intercepted a pass on the final play of the third quarter and returned it 61 yards for a touchdown putting EIU up 21-14. The freshman finished with seven tackles and a half tackle for loss.
- Nick Bruno knocked home the game winning 38-yard field goal in overtime as the Panthers beat UT Martin 24-21 to win the 101st EIU homecoming game. It was the first game winning field goal by an EIU kicker since Cameron Berra hit one in overtime to beat Southern Illinois in September of 2013.
- Eastern Illinois has now played 16 overtime games in school history including seven under current head coach Kim Dameron. The Panthers are 10-6 in overtime games with a five game overtime win streak. Last season EIU was 3-0 in overtime including two double overtime wins.
- Alexander Hollins caught his 13th touchdown pass of the season against UT Martin as the senior continues to lead the FCS in touchdown receptions. He has now caught at least one touchdown pass in six straight games. He is now tied for fourth on the EIU single season touchdown reception list and seventh on the OVC single season list.
- Eastern Illinois had four players record double figure tackles on Saturday against UT Martin as the Skyhawks ran 91 plays on offense. Dytarious Johnson and Joe Caputo both had 13 tackles on defense followed by Edwyn Brown (11) and Levi Watson (10).

THE SERIES

 Eastern Illinois and Eastern Kentucky will be meeting for the 26th time on Saturday. The two teams rank in the top seven all-time in FCS playoff appearances with a combined 37 appearances. EKU holds a 13-12 all-time series lead but the Panthers have won three straight in the series and five of the last six. EIU won 23-20 in overtime last season when Bradley Dewberry intercepted a pass. The Panthers won in Richmond in 2016 with a 24-0 victory behind back-up quarterback Jared Pilson.

- Sophomore Dytarious Johnson made a run at the EIU single game tackles for loss record as he finished with 5.5 against UT Martin on Saturday. The school record is seven set by Trevor Frericks in November of 2009 against Tennessee State. Johnson was the first EIU player since Frericks to record five or more TFL in a game. The last EIU player with four or more TFL in a game was Nick Horne with four on Nov. 19, 2016 against Eastern Kentucky. Johnson now has 11 tackles for loss this season to rank 34th in the FCS and second in the OVC.
- Eastern Illinois defense faced a UT Martin offense that ran 91 plays on Saturday. As a result EIU had four players finish with double figure tackles in the game. Dytarious Johnson and Joe Caputo each had 13 tackles while Edwyn Brown registered 11 and Levi Watson ten. It was the third time this season that EIU had multiple players finish with double figure tackles. The last time EIU had four players finish a game with double figure tackles was Oct. 11, 2014 during a 36-33 overtime loss at Eastern Kentucky.
- Edwyn Brown finished with 11 tackles on Saturday against UT Martin as the redshirt freshman had his first double figure tackle game of his career. He added a half tackle for loss. Brown ranks eighth on the EIU tackles list this year with 34.
- Bryce Dewberry picked off a pass to end the third quarter and returned it 61 yards for a touchdown against UT Martin. It was the first defensive touchdown by the Panthers since the 2017 season opener when Mark Williams picked off a pass and returned it 73 yards for a touchdown against Indiana State.
- EIU had two turnovers gained against UT Martin as the Panthers have now posted five straight games with multiple turnovers gained after not forcing a turnover in the first three contests of the year. It marked the 30th time under head coach Kim Dameron that the Panthers have forced two or more turnovers in a game. EIU now has 11 turnovers gained this season to rank 58th in the FCS and fifth in the OVC.
- Eastern Illinois had 10.5 tackles for loss as a team on Saturday against UT Martin. It was the first time this season that EIU had recorded double figure tackles for loss in a game. As a team EIU now has 43 tackles for loss on the season to rank 90th in the FCS. The last time EIU had double figure tackles for loss in a game was last season in the home finale against Eastern Kentucky.
- Nick Bruno was 3-of-3 on extra points to go along with his game winning 38-yard field goal. Bruno is now 139-of-143 in career extra points which ranks second on the EIU career list. Bruno is 9-of-11 on field goals this season and 40-of-56 for his Panther career. The 40 field goals rank second all-time at EIU. Bruno needs six field goals to tie Steve Largent for the school record. With his six points on Saturday, Bruno moved into fifth on the EIU career list for scoring with 259 points. He needs one point to climb to fourth.
- Nick Bruno was effective punting the football in extreme wind conditions on Saturday against UT Martin. Facing winds in the 40 mph range with gusts up to 60 mph, Bruno averaged 38.5 yards per punt on eight punts with five pinned inside the 20-yard line and another just bouncing in for a touchback. On the season Bruno is averaging 39.8 yards per punt with 16 downed inside the 20 and a long punt of 56 yards.
- For the second straight game Eastern Illinois had its run game stuffed by the opponent. The Panthers rushed for 27 yards on 23 carries for a 1.2 yards per carry average. The previous week EIU had 15 yards on 19 carries at Jacksonville State. For the season EIU is averaging 113.9 yards per game on the ground and 3.9 yards per carry.
- Eastern Illinois possessed the football for just 18:47 on Saturday against UT Martin as the Panthers ran 53 plays on offense. The last time EIU had the ball for less than 20 minutes in a game was the final game of 2017 at Austin Peay. The last time EIU won a game having the ball less than 20 minutes was Oct. 10, 2013 when the Panthers had the ball for 18:47 during a 63-7 win at Austin Peay.

- Alexander Hollins was limited to his lowest receiving yards total of the season against UT Martin as he finished with 42 yards. Hollins has 868 yards this season to rank sixth in the FCS this season. He needs 32 yards to become the 13th player in school history with 900 or more yards receiving in one season. Hollins is now 14th on the EIU career receiving yards list with 1,562 yards. He needs 138 yards to catch Mike Rummell in 13th place with 1,700 career yards.
- Alexander Hollins was held to just three receptions on Saturday against UT Martin, the senior's lowest total of the year. One of those was good for his FCS leading 13th touchdown. Hollins has 66 catches this season which ranks fifth in the FCS and second in the OVC behind Chris Rowland of Tennessee State.
- Senior Aaron Gooch caught a team-high four passes on Saturday against UT Martin as the Panthers were held to just 15 receptions for the game. Gooch now has 46 catches for the season to rank 26th in the FCS and fourth in the OVC this year. Gooch has 115 career catches and needs 11 more receptions to move into the EIU career top 10. Ryan Voss and Rob Mehalic are both tied for ninth with 126 career catches. Teammate Alexander Hollins has 113 career catches.
- Aaron Gooch added 19 yards to his season and career receiving yards total on Saturday. Gooch climbed into 23rd on the EIU career list with 1,141 yards. Gooch needs eight yards to tie Kenny Whittaker for 22nd on the list. This season Gooch has 527 receiving yards which places the senior 43rd in the FCS.
- Senior running back Isaiah Johnson continues his slow march to 1,000 career yards. Johnson has 971 career rushing yards as he looks to become the 29th EIU player to pass the 1,000 yard mark for their career. Johnson has been held to 17 yards in the last two games after not playing against Murray State. On Sept. 29 he rushed for 161 yards in the win at Tennessee Tech.
- Quarterback Johnathan Brantley continued his season long streak of not throwing an interception. Brantley has now attempted 230 straight passes without an interception. He broke the OVC record previously held by Murray State's Casey Brockman against Jacksonville State. The FCS record for consecutive passes thrown without an interception is 342 set by Jimmy Blanchard of Portland State in 1999. The FCS record for highest number of passes thrown during an entire season without an interception is 150 set by current NFL quarterback Ryan Fitzpatrick during the 2002 season at Harvard.
- Harry Woodbery had the lone touchdown pass of the game for Eastern Illinois as he connected with Alexander Hollins. Woodbery now has 10 touchdown passes on the season. He has passed for 1,027 yards going 87-of-150 with four interceptions. Woodbery's best performance was a 339 yard game at Tennessee Tech.
- Eastern Illinois has used a combination of quarterbacks this season with Johnathan Brantley and Harry Woodbery splitting time at the position. Brantley has passed for 1,553 yards and 12 touchdowns while Woodbery has 1,027 yards and ten touchdowns. Brantley is currently ninth in the FCS in completion percentage at 67 percent while Woodbery is 54th at 58 percent. Combined the two quarterbacks have helped EIU pass for 2,580 yards to rank fifth in the FCS in passing offense. EIU ranks 17th in completion percentage and third in the nation in passing touchdowns.
- On Saturday Eastern Illinois had the unique feat of not recording one official kickoff return or punt return during their win over UT Martin. All six punt attempts by UTM went for either a touchback, fair catch or were downed by the Skyhawks. Of the four kickoffs by UTM two went for touchbacks while the other two were fair catches. The last time EIU did not record an official punt return in a game was earlier this season at Illinois State. The last time EIU did not record an official kickoff return in a game was Sept. 28, 2013 against Eastern Kentucky. In that game EIU also had one official punt return for one yard during a 42-7 win over the Colonels.

EIU HEAD COACH KIM DAMERON

Kim Dameron is in his fifth season as the Eastern Illinois head football coach. Dameron led the Panthers to the FCS playoffs in 2015 as EIU was ranked 23rd in the final FCS Coaches poll. Dameron was the defensive coordinator at Louisiana Tech prior to taking the EIU head job and has more than 15 years of experience as a defensive coordinator with more than 30 years of experience as a college coach. Dameron served as the EIU defensive coordinator in 2000 helping the program rebound from a 2-10 season in 1999 to an 8-4 record and FCS playoff appearance in 2000. Dameron played football at Arkansas appearing in four bowl games between 1979-82. He is a 1983 graduate of Arkansas. Complete Coach Kim Dameron bio available on page 6 of EIU game notes...

EASTERN KENTUCKY HEAD COACH MARK ELDER

Mark Elder became the 14th head coach at Eastern Kentucky in 2016 and has a 10-19 career mark with the Colonels. A 2000 graduate of Case Western Reserve, Elder immediately found success as a graduate assistant coach at Akron helping the team win a East Division Championship his first year. He has had coaching stops at seven different schools as an assistant coach helping teams reach nine bowl games. Prior to taking over at EKU he was the special teams and tight ends coach at Tennessee for three seasons.

SCOUTING EASTERN KENTUCKY

Eastern Kentucky enters the game with a 3-4 record following a home loss last weekend to Murray State. The Colonels have been led by a defense that ranks fifth in the nation in turnovers gained with 19. However on offense, EKU has hurt themselves with 16 turnovers leading to 69 points for opponents. Daryl McCleskey (530 yards) and LJ Scott (447 yards) lead a run heavy offense that averages 227 yards per game on the ground. EKU's top three receivers all have 12 catches while three quarterbacks have seen time under center. Gavin Bascom leads the Colonels defense with 50 tackles. Aaron Patrick has eight tackles for loss and five sacks.

ON THIS DATE IN EIU HISTORY

Oct. 27, 1973 - On a rainy day in Charleston, Nate Anderson carried the football 42 times for a then school record 268 yards as Eastern Illinois beat Saint Joseph's of Indiana, 34-14. Anderson helped ice the game with an 88 yard scamper midway through the fourth quarter. On defense EIU picked off five passes with Rick Dahl collecting three interceptions.

HOLLINS JOINS OVC SINGLE SEASON LIST

Alexander Hollins caught his 13th touchdown pass of the season on Saturday against UT Martin moving the senior into an 8-player tie for seventh on the OVC single season list. He joins former EIU players Adam Drake, Micah Rucker and Will Bumphus on the list. Former Panther Erik Lora is the EIU & OVC single season leader with 19 touchdown catches in 2013.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.

OVC SUCCESS

KIM DAMERON (Arkansas, 1983) -- 5th Season

(Career Record 24-23, 21-11 OVC)

Kim Dameron was hired as the 24th head coach in program history and the fifth in the NCAA Division I era in January of 2014

The 2017 season may have been one of the most pulse stopping in recent years as the Panthers posted their third straight winning season under Dameron with all six victories coming by three points or less with a total margin of victory of 15 points for the year. Three of the wins were in overtime with two of them coming in double overtime. The wins on the season came in a variety of ways with two last play touchdown wins, two defensive stands, one game winning field goal and one game winning field goal block. EIU placed seven players on the All-OVC team and had defensive back Mark Williams earn Freshman All-American honors.

In 2016 the Panthers quickly climbed into the FCS playoff picture as they knocked off FBS member Miami (Ohio) and beat No. 5 ranked Illinois State in the Mid-America Classic. Dameron would guide EIU to a No. 13 ranking in the polls at the midway portion of the season. The Panthers would face several key injuries late in the season and finished the year at 6-5 overall following a 24-0 win at Eastern Kentucky to end the season. EIU was 4-4 in the OVC. The Panthers had four players earn All-OVC honors with Devin Church and Seth McDonald both earning first team honors.

Dameron returned the Panthers to the FCS playoffs in 2015 as EIU won seven of their last eight regular season games

to finish with a 7-4 regular season record. EIU lost in the opening round of the FCS playoffs at Northern Iowa. The Panthers were ranked No. 23 in the final FCS Coaches poll after making their 16th all-time FCS playoff appearance. During the season Dameron's team produced six All-OVC players including co-Defensive Player of the Year Dino Fanti. Dameron would have his first player from Eastern Illinois drafted in May of 2016 when linebacker Kamu Grugier-Hill became a sixth round selection of the New England Patriots.

In his first season Dameron coached the Panthers to a 5-7 record including 5-3 in the Ohio Valley Conference as the Panthers were in the championship race until the final weeks of the season. Dameron's first career victory came on Sept. 20 against Austin Peay as the Panthers won 63-7. In the game EIU tied a school record for rushing yards with 413. The team featured three All-American selections including first team offensive lineman Collin Seibert and freshman All-American kicker Nick Bruno. Dameron's squad had five first team All-OVC selections and five second team All-OVC honorees. The team was among the best on both sides of the ball in the OVC ranking second in total offense (11th nationally) and third in total defense.

Dameron spent the 2013 season as the defensive coordinator at Louisiana Tech where he directed a much improved defensive unit. The Bulldogs finished ranked 69th in the nation in total defense under Dameron's direction after being ranked 120th the previous season. Dameron's defense was the fourth most-improved squad in the FBS last season.

An experienced defensive coach with more than 15 years as a defensive coordinator Dameron took over an Eastern Illinois program that advanced to the FCS playoff quarterfinals last season. It is Dameron's second stint in Charleston as he previously worked as the defensive coordinator at EIU in 2000 as a member of head coach Bob Spoo's staff. During that 2000 season, Dameron helped transform the Panthers defense as they rebounded from a 2-10 season in 1999 to 8-4 and Ohio Valley Conference Champions in 2000.

Dameron spent three seasons as the safeties coach at Ole Miss as the team appeared in two Cotton Bowls. Two of his players were selected in the NFL draft as his pass defense unit ranked 11th in the NCAA in pass efficiency defense and 15th in pass defense.

Prior to his stint at Ole Miss, Dameron was the defensive coordinator at Louisiana-Monroe as the program became bowl eligible at the FBS level for the first time in 2007 while also picking up a win over Alabama. The ULM defense led the Sun Belt Conference in fewest points allowed and ranking third nationally in turnovers gained.

Dameron has previous stops as the defensive coordinator at Stephen F. Austin and as the secondary coach at Cincinnati and UNLV. He spent the 1999 season as the secondary coach in the Canadian Football League with the Toronto Argonauts.

He has previous FCS coaching experience on the staffs of Murray State and Missouri State where he helped coach both teams to FCS playoff appearances.

Dameron began his coaching career as a graduate assistant

under Lou Holtz at Arkansas, his alma mater, after earning his degree. He was a fouryear player for the Razorbacks from 1979-82 at wide receiver and defensive back. As a Razorback he participated in four bowl games including the 1979 Sugar Bowl.

Dameron and his wife Debbie, have one daughter Krystle. Krystle and her husband Mike, gave birth to daughter Emma the day prior to Dameron coaching his first collegiate game as a head coach on August 28, 2014 at Minnesota. Dameron has since added another granddaughter Ava.

RECAP

Illinois State stopped Eastern Illinois on a fourth and one at the 3-yard line to end a Panthers drive midway through the second quarter. On the first play of the Redbirds offensive possession No. 19 ISU capitalized with a 97-yard touchdown pass from Brady Davis to Spencer Schnell to help the Redbirds win the 107th Mid-America Classic 48-10.
