EIU Hosts UT Martin For 101st Homecoming Game

Eastern Illinois vs. UT Martin O'Brien Field (10,000) • Charleston, Ill. October 20, 2018 • 2 p.m. • TV: ESPN3

NOTES TO KNOW

- Johnathan Brantley set the Ohio Valley Conference record for consecutive passes without an interception as he went 28-of-39 at Jacksonville State. Brantley has a streak of 213 straight passes without an interception. The previous OVC record was 207 by Casey Brockman of Murray State set in 2012.
- Alexander Hollins caught his 12th touchdown pass of the season at Jacksonville State as the senior leads the FCS in touchdown receptions. He is now tied for seventh on the EIU single season touchdowns list with Adam Drake and Erik Lora. Hollins has now caught at least one touchdown in five straight games.
- Long time Eastern Illinois football coach Bob Spoo passed away in Rockford, Ill., earlier this week (Monday). Spoo was the Panthers head coach for 25 years (1987-2011) winning 144 games with nine FCS playoff appearances, 11 FCS Top 25 end of year rankings and five conference championships. He was inducted into both the Eastern Illinois and Ohio Valley Conference Hall of Fame.
- Eastern Illinois run game was shut down at Jacksonville State as the Panthers rushed for 15 yards on 19 carries against the Gamecocks. Quarterback Johnathan Brantley was the leading rusher with 18 yards on 10 carries. Robert Columbus was the only EIU running back of three that played that finished with positive yards in the game (+1).
- Eastern Illinois will be playing its 101st homecoming game. EIU is 51-41-8 all-time on homecoming. This will be fourth time EIU has hosted UT Martin for homecoming with a 2-1 record in previous meetings.

THE SERIES

• Eastern Illinois and UT Martin will be meeting for the 24th time when the Panthers and Skyhawks meet on Saturday. EIU holds a 14-9 all-time series lead but the Skyhawks have an 8-4 series advantage since current UTM head coach Jason Simpson took over the program in 2006. The Skyhawks have won two straight. EIU's last win in the series was in 2015 as they beat UT Martin 23-21 en route to the Panthers 16th FCS playoff appearance.

- Alexander Hollins continues his climb up the Eastern Illinois career receiving charts as he caught ten passes for 93 yards at Jacksonville State. Hollis now has 1,520 career yards which places him 15th on the Panthers all-time list. He needs 35 yards to tie former All-American James Warring for 14th on the career list.
- Alexander Hollins moved his season receptions total to 63 on Saturday at Jacksonville State. Hollins is currently fourth in the FCS in receptions and has 110 receptions for his career. Hollins needs two more receptions to move into a tie for 9th on the EIU single season receptions list. He needs 16 receptions to move into the EIU career top ten.
- While Alexander Hollins moves up the EIU career receiving yards list for the Panthers, he also is close to cracking the EIU single season list for receiving yards. Hollins enters the weekend fourth in the nation in receiving yards with 826. He is looking to become just the 13th player in school history with 900 or more yards receiving in a season.
- While Alexander Hollins may be among the top statistical receivers in the nation, teammate Aaron Gooch remains among the top receivers in the OVC. Gooch is second on the Panthers roster with 42 receptions which is 26th in the FCS and fourth in the conference. For his career Gooch has hauled in 111 passes as he looks to crack the EIU career top ten for receptions needing 15 receptions to join the list.
- Aaron Gooch passed the 500 yards receiving mark for the season at Jacksonville State as the senior is 55th in the nation with 508 yards receiving this season. Two weeks ago against Murray State, Gooch became the 32nd player in school history to join the 1,000 yards receiving club. Gooch is currently 26th on the EIU list with 1,122 career yards.
- In addition to his pass catching abilities, Aaron Gooch also serves as the Panthers punt returner. As a junior Gooch ranked first in the OVC and 22nd in the FCS in punt return average at 8.7 yards per return. This season Gooch is averaging 6 yards per return which is 42nd in the NCAA. Gooch needs 26 punt return yards this season to move into the Panthers career top ten for punt return yards. His career average is 6.5 per return.
- Receivers Aaron Gooch, Nick Atoyebi and James Sheehan have started all seven games together as part of the Panthers wide receiving corps this year. The three were all teammates at Homewood-Flossmoor High School helping the program advance to the second round of the IHSA Class 8A state playoffs in 2013. Atoyebi and Gooch were seniors on that team while Sheehan was a junior.
- Johnathan Brantley had two fourth quarter touchdown passes at Jacksonville State as the junior transfer from Tulane has now thrown 12 touchdowns this season. Brantley is 23rd in the FCS in touchdown passes this season. Combined with quarterback Harry Woodbery the Panthers have 21 touchdown passes this season which ranks second in the nation behind Samford with 26. EIU is fourth in the nation in passing offense.
- Johnathan Brantley was 28-of-39 on Saturday at Jacksonville State as he is now 145-of-213 for the season. Brantley's 68.1 completion percentage ranks him sixth in the FCS this season. The school record for completion percentage in a season is 68.3 percent held by Mike Simpson during the 1997 season.
- After committing five turnovers in the season opener at Arkansas, the Eastern Illinois offense has done a better job of holding on to the football over the last six games. EIU has a total of ten turnovers lost for the season with three interceptions and seven fumbles. The three interceptions ranks as the 17th lowest total in the nation this season and second among schools that have 200 or more passing attempts (Dayton 2 INT / 210 passes).
- Running back Isaiah Johnson enters the weekend needing 50 yards to become the 29th player in school history with 1,000 or more career rushing yards.

- With the injury bug hitting the Eastern Illinois defense this season, the Panthers have now converted three former offensive players that have started at least one game on defense. On Saturday former running back Darshon McCullough started at one of the safety positions. McCullough is a mid-season conversion after rushing for 29 yards and a touchdown. Nolan Dean (former running back) and Javon Turner (former wide receiver) moved over to defense earlier this fall.
- Javon Turner came off the bench as a back-up defensive back at Jacksonville State and finished the game with a team high eight tackles. Turner has one start this season at Tennessee Tech. A converted wide receiver he has made 25 tackles this season with two pass break-ups. It was the second time this season that Turner has led the Panthers in tackles for a game.
- Converted running back Nolan Dean finished the game with five tackles at Jacksonville State as he played as a reserve linebacker in the contest after starting the two previous games. Dean has made 31 tackles this season with three tackles for loss, one sack and a forced fumble.
- Mark Williams had his second interception of the season at Jacksonville State as he made four tackles in the game prior to exiting with an injury. Williams is third on the team with 36 total tackles and is the team leader with 30 solo stops. He has added three pass break-ups to give him 14 for his career. He has five career interceptions.
- DySaun Smith had his first career interception on Saturday at Jacksonville State. Smith finished the game with three tackles. For the season Smith has 29 tackles and a team-high four pass break-ups. Smith now has 14 career pass break-ups. A fifth-year senior Smith graduated with a 3.17 GPA in marketing last spring and is currently enrolled in the master's program for sports management.
- Freshman Bryce Dewberry made his first career start on Saturday at Jacksonville State and responded with seven tackles including five solo stops. For the season Dewberry has played in all seven games with 13 tackles, a pass break-up and a forced fumble.
- Sophomore Austin Johnson made his first appearance of the season for the Panthers as he started at Jacksonville State. Johnson finished the game with three tackles including one of the two sacks EIU recorded on the day.
- EIU had two turnovers gained against Jacksonville State as the Panthers have now posted four straight games with multiple turnovers gained after not forcing a turnover in the first three contests of the year. It marked the 29th time under head coach Kim Dameron that the Panthers have forced two or more turnovers in a game.
- Nick Bruno was 3-of-3 on field goal attempts against Jacksonville State knocking home kicks from 27, 40 and 36 yards out. For his career Bruno is now 39-of-55 on field goals with a career long of 48 yards coming earlier this year against Tennessee State. His 39 field goals made rank second on the EIU career list.
- Nick Bruno was 1-of-2 on extra point attempts against Jacksonville State as he is now 22-of-24 for the season. For his career Bruno is 136-of-140 on extra points as he ranks second on the EIU career list. Bruno now has 253 career points as he ranks sixth all-time on the EIU scoring list. He needs five points to tie former running back Vincent Webb for fifth on the list.
- Eastern Illinois will be playing its 101st homecoming game on Saturday when the Panthers host the Skyhawks. EIU has lost its last two homecoming games and holds a 51-41-8 all-time homecoming record. This will be the fourth time that EIU has hosted UT Martin on homecoming with a 2-1 record in those previous match-ups.

EIU HEAD COACH KIM DAMERON

Kim Dameron is in his fifth season as the Eastern Illinois head football coach. Dameron led the Panthers to the FCS playoffs in 2015 as EIU was ranked 23rd in the final FCS Coaches poll. Dameron was the defensive coordinator at Louisiana Tech prior to taking the EIU head job and has more than 15 years of experience as a defensive coordinator with more than 30 years of experience as a college coach. Dameron served as the EIU defensive coordinator in 2000 helping the program rebound from a 2-10 season in 1999 to an 8-4 record and FCS playoff appearance in 2000. Dameron played football at Arkansas appearing in four bowl games between 1979-82. He is a 1983 graduate of Arkansas. Complete Coach Kim Dameron bio available on page 6 of EIU game notes...

UT MARTIN HEAD COACH JASON SIMPSON

Jason Simpson is currently the longest tenured head coach in the Ohio Valley Conference entering his 13th season with UT Martin. In his debut season of 2006, Simpson earned OVC Coach of the Year honors as he led the Skyhawks to a share of the OVC Championship and the school's first FCS Playoff appearance. He has posted a record of 79-64 with an OVC mark of 62-36. The 79 career wins rank him second all-time at UT Martin. Simpson is a 1995 graduate of Southern Mississippi where he played baseball.

SCOUTING UT MARTIN

Much like Eastern Illinois, UT Martin had aspirations of challenging for the OVC Championship as the Skyhawks were picked to finish third in the OVC preseason football poll. Quarterback Dresser Winn has passed for 1,553 yards and 12 touchdowns but does have nine interceptions. His favorite target has been Terry Williams with 48 catches for 506 yards. On defense Kevin Prather has been dominant with 9.5 tackles for loss and 2.5 sacks as part of his team high 44 tackles this season.

ON THIS DATE IN EIU HISTORY

Oct. 20, 1984 - After giving up 33 or more points in the four previous weeks, Eastern Illinois defense clamped down during a 14-0 win over Western Illinois. The defense allowed just 14 yards rushing while forcing five turnovers. DuWayne Pitts scored on a 1-yard run and Derick Wilhems returned an interception for a touchdown for the Panthers scoring. In the game receiver Jerry Wright set the then school receiving yards record of 2,238 career yards.

BOB SPOO REMEMBERED

Former long time Eastern Illinois head football coach Bob Spoo passed away on Monday. Spoo served as the Panthers head coach for 25 seasons leading the program to 144 wins, nine FCS playoff appearances, five conference championships and 11 top 25 rankings.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth alltime among FCS schools.

OVC SUCCESS

KIM DAMERON (Arkansas, 1983) -- 5th Season (Career Record 24-23, 21-11 OVC)

Kim Dameron was hired as the 24th head coach in program history and the fifth in the NCAA Division I era in January of 2014.

The 2017 season may have been one of the most pulse stopping in recent years as the Panthers posted their third straight winning season under Dameron with all six victories coming by three points or less with a total margin of victory of 15 points for the year. Three of the wins were in overtime with two of them coming in double overtime. The wins on the season came in a variety of ways with two last play touchdown wins, two defensive stands, one game winning field goal and one game winning field goal block. EIU placed seven players on the All-OVC team and had defensive back Mark Williams earn Freshman All-American honors.

In 2016 the Panthers quickly climbed into the FCS playoff picture as they knocked off FBS member Miami (Ohio) and beat No. 5 ranked Illinois State in the Mid-America Classic. Dameron would guide EIU to a No. 13 ranking in the polls at the midway portion of the season. The Panthers would face several key injuries late in the season and finished the year at 6-5 overall following a 24-0 win at Eastern Kentucky to end the season. EIU was 4-4 in the OVC. The Panthers had four players earn All-OVC honors with Devin Church and Seth McDonald both earning first team honors.

Dameron returned the Panthers to the FCS playoffs in 2015 as EIU won seven of their last eight regular season games

to finish with a 7-4 regular season record. EIU lost in the opening round of the FCS playoffs at Northern Iowa. The Panthers were ranked No. 23 in the final FCS Coaches poll after making their 16th all-time FCS playoff appearance. During the season Dameron's team produced six All-OVC players including co-Defensive Player of the Year Dino Fanti. Dameron would have his first player from Eastern Illinois drafted in May of 2016 when linebacker Kamu Grugier-Hill became a sixth round selection of the New England Patriots.

In his first season Dameron coached the Panthers to a 5-7 record including 5-3 in the Ohio Valley Conference as the Panthers were in the championship race until the final weeks of the season. Dameron's first career victory came on Sept. 20 against Austin Peay as the Panthers won 63-7. In the game EIU tied a school record for rushing yards with 413. The team featured three All-American selections including first team offensive lineman Collin Seibert and freshman All-American kicker Nick Bruno. Dameron's squad had five first team All-OVC selections and five second team All-OVC honorees. The team was among the best on both sides of the ball in the OVC ranking second in total offense (11th nationally) and third in total defense.

Dameron spent the 2013 season as the defensive coordinator at Louisiana Tech where he directed a much improved defensive unit. The Bulldogs finished ranked 69th in the nation in total defense under Dameron's direction after being ranked 120th the previous season. Dameron's defense was the fourth most-improved squad in the FBS last season.

An experienced defensive coach with more than 15 years as a defensive coordinator Dameron took over an Eastern Illinois program that advanced to the FCS playoff quarterfinals last season. It is Dameron's second stint in Charleston as he previously worked as the defensive coordinator at EIU in 2000 as a member of head coach Bob Spoo's staff. During that 2000 season, Dameron helped transform the Panthers defense as they rebounded from a 2-10 season in 1999 to 8-4 and Ohio Valley Conference Champions in 2000.

Dameron spent three seasons as the safeties coach at Ole Miss as the team appeared in two Cotton Bowls. Two of his players were selected in the NFL draft as his pass defense unit ranked 11th in the NCAA in pass efficiency defense and 15th in pass defense.

Prior to his stint at Ole Miss, Dameron was the defensive coordinator at Louisiana-Monroe as the program became bowleligible at the FBS level for the first time in 2007 while also picking up a win over Alabama. The ULM defense led the Sun Belt Conference in fewest points allowed and ranking third nationally in turnovers gained.

Dameron has previous stops as the defensive coordinator at Stephen F. Austin and as the secondary coach at Cincinnati and UNLV. He spent the 1999 season as the secondary coach in the Canadian Football League with the Toronto Argonauts.

He has previous FCS coaching experience on the staffs of Murray State and Missouri State where he helped coach both teams to FCS playoff appearances.

Dameron began his coaching career as a graduate assistant

under Lou Holtz at Arkansas, his alma mater, after earning his degree. He was a fouryear player for the Razorbacks from 1979-82 at wide receiver and defensive back. As a Razorback he participated in four bowl games including the 1979 Sugar Bowl.

Dameron and his wife Debbie, have one daughter Krystle. Krystle and her husband Mike, gave birth to daughter Emma the day prior to Dameron coaching his first collegiate game as a head coach on August 28, 2014 at Minnesota. Dameron has since added another granddaughter Ava.
