#### **GAME 3**

Eastern Illinois plays its home opener on Saturday night as the Panthers host instate rival Western Illinois in Lantz Arena. EIU suffered road losses at Texas and IUPUI to open the season at 0-2. The Panthers shot below 40 percent from the field in both contests. Following the home game, EIU will play three games over Thanksgiving Weekend at the VisitCurrituckOBX.com Battle in the Blue Ridge Tournament in Asheville, North Carolina on Nov. 23-25. Western Illinois enters at 2-1 on the season with two wins over lower division opponents.

#### **FIVE FINISH IN DOUBLE FIGURES**

Eastern Illinois had five players score in double figures during the Panthers 71-65 loss at IUPUI last Saturday. The five players were the only players to score for EIU with four of the five starters scoring points. Ben Harvey added ten points off the bench. The last time EIU had five players score in double figures in a game was Jan. 20, 2018 in an 86-74 loss to Southeast Missouri.

#### KNOCKING THEM DOWN FROM THE LINE

Eastern Illinois was 21-of-26 at the free throw line at IUPUI finishing with an 80.8 clip at the stripe. The Panthers had opened the season going 13-of-18 from the line at Texas for 72.2 percent. On the season EIU is shooting 77.3 percent from the foul line which is currently first in the Ohio Valley Conference and 40th in the NCAA as EIU is 34-of-44 for the season. All four players that have attempted five or more free throws this season for EIU are shooting over 71 percent. Western Illinois leads the NCAA in free throw percentage at 87 percent (40-of-46).

#### **EASTERN ILLINOIS HEAD COACH JAY SPOONHOUR**

Jay Spoonhour is in his seventh season as the Panthers head coach having been hired on April 9, 2012. Spoonhour was previously the head coach at Moberly Area Community College where he coached for three seasons. He was a long time assistant coach at the NCAA Division I level and served as the interim head coach at UNLV to complete the 2004 season posting a 6-4 record and taking the team to the finals of the Mountain West Conference Tournament along with an NIT appearance. In 2001 Spoonhour was named the National Junior College Coach of the Year leading Wabash Valley College to the NJCAA National Championship with a 36-1 record. He is the son of the late legendary coach Charlie Spoonhour. Spoonhour played basketball at Pittsburg State earning his degree in 1994. He was an honorable mention All-Conference selection. He has assistant coaching stops at Central Missouri, Saint Louis, UNLV, Missouri and Texas San Antonio. Spoonhour's career mark is 185-140; 85-112 at the NCAA Division I level. His EIU record is 79-108 with an OVC mark of 44-54. Spoonhour led the program to its first NCAA Division I postseason win on March 17, 2015 with a 97-91 win at Oakland in the CIT.

#### LAST TIME OUT

IUPUI held off a late Eastern Illinois rally as the Jaguars won 71-65, dropping EIU to 0-2 to start the season. Five players scored in double figures for EIU with Rade Kukobat leading the way with 18 points. IUPUI was 10-of-15 from the free throw line to close out the win.

#### **SCOUTING WESTERN ILLINOIS**

Billy Wright is in his fourth season as the head coach at Western Illinois. The Leathernecks are 2-1 on the year with their two wins coming at home over lower division opponents. Kobe Webster leads WIU at 18.7 points per game with Isaac Johnson just behind averaging 17 points per game. Western Illinois is averaging 82 points per game shooting 47 percent from the floor.

#### **SERIES INFORMATION**

This will be the 162nd meeting between Eastern Illinois and Western Illinois. Western Illinois holds an 81-80 all-time series lead after splitting the two games in the season series last year. WIU won 56-54 in Macomb while EIU won just before Christmas break, 78-77 in Charleston. EIU has won three of the last four meetings. The two schools recently revived the series as a traveling trophy game with the winner taking home the Old Railsplitter Axe as the prize.

- Rade Kukobat led the Panthers in scoring for a second straight game as the junior college transfer had 18 points and seven rebounds at IUPUI. Kukobat opened the season with 12 points at Texas. Kukobat is currently 14th in the OVC in scoring this season at 15 points per game.
- Shareef Smith was 4-of-6 from the field against IUPUI as he scored 13 points. Smith is now shooting 63.6 percent for the season and ranks fifth in the OVC in field goal percentage. He is third in the OVC in steals per game with 2.5 per contest.
- Mack Smith knocked down 2-of-3 shots from 3-point range as he scored 12 points at IUPUI. Smith has scored in double figures in both of the Panthers games this season averaging 11.5 points per game. Last season he was named to the OVC All-Newcomer team averaging 12.4 points per game.
- Josiah Wallace finished with 12 points at IUPUI giving the junior college transfer his first double figure scoring game of the season. Last season as a freshman at Olney Central College, Wallace ranked 15th in the nation in scoring at 21.2 points per game.
- Ben Harvey scored ten points off the bench at IUPUI going 4-of-9 from the field. Harvey is averaging 7.5 points per game and is the top producer off the bench this season for the Panthers. He had five points at Texas.
- Redshirt senior Terrell Lewis returned to action for the first time since suffering a season ending ankle injury last year at Green Bay when he played seven minutes off the bench at IUPUI. Last season Lewis became just the ninth player in OVC history with 1,000 points and 500 assists. He was a preseason All-OVC selection this year.
- Freshman Cam Burrell continues to contribute on the glass and on the defensive end of the floor. In the opener at Texas, Burrell had five rebounds and two blocked shots. At IUPUI Burrell added another two blocked shots and a rebound. He is currently tied for fourth in the OVC in blocked shots. As a team EIU has nine blocks which is fourth in the conference.
- · Eastern Illinois added junior college forward Jordan Skipper-Brown to next year's roster during the early signing period. Skipper-Brown is in his second year at McLennan JC in Texas averaging 18 points per game. He was an All-Area selection at River Ridge HS in Olympia, Washington.
